This website is operated in full compliance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation 2018.

Any information provided by the user will be used solely for the purposes it has been submitted. Information can be provided by the user by completing the enquiry form in the 'Contact Us' section.

Any information disclosed to the Isle of Gigha Heritage Trust via the website will not be passed on to any third parties.

Availability of holiday cottages can be viewed using this website but all bookings are directed to a secure booking channel, so that no personal data is displayed or stored on the Isle of Gigha website.

The Isle of Gigha website uses Cookies. A 'Cookie' is a small text file that is downloaded onto 'terminal equipment' (e.g. a computer or smartphone) when the user accesses a website. It allows the website to recognise that user's device and store some information about the user's preferences or past actions.

The following statement is displayed when viewing the website for the first time to notify the user that Cookies is in use: 'We use cookies to ensure you get the best possible experience on this website'. (This statement will appear periodically thereafter.) There is also an option to 'learn more' about Cookies which opens a new page explaining how to disable Cookies. If the user wishes to consent to Cookies, the user clicks on the 'accept' option. Clicking on the 'accept' option demonstrates a clear affirmative action that the user is consenting to Cookies.
